Dear Parishioners.

Do difficult people feel they have a mission from God? Do they hear God saying, "Your ultimate work in life is to be difficult; do everything in your power to irritate others; be irresponsible, demanding, selfish, and anary"?

Many of us have had to deal with difficult people in our lives. Since they refuse to change, we cannot allow them to draw us into their world of yelling, screaming, spewing insults, or using either intimidation or manipulation. When this happens, they've got us. We're now operating on their unChristian or antisocial level.

The key to dealing with people like this is to take responsibility. We are absolutely accountable for how we treat others; but we are not to blame for how they treat us. We can control, however, our reaction to their behavior. The next time someone upsets you, try the advice of Jesus: "Love your enemies!" Then respond with understanding and compassion, or if unable to do so at the moment, then at least with feigned indifference. Often, they're hurting inside, but would be absolutely loathe due to pride to admit it. Don't allow unkind words to get to you. Breathe deeply and remember that they are children of God, beloved by him. Respond with understanding and compassion. If you know them or have the opportunity to get to know them, help them find a true sense of self-worth.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION RE-REGISTRATION

Re-Registration Forms may be returned in person or through the mail to the Religious Education Office at: P.O. Box 56, Keyport, NJ 07735.

Please make any necessary corrections and include the non-refundable registration fee as follows:

1 Child \$100.00 2 Children \$150.00 3 or More \$180.00

Re-Registration MUST be received before June 14, 2011. After that date NO-re-registrations will be taken until AFTER August 29, 2011. A \$50.00 late re-registration fee would be due at that time, and the student will only be accepted if there is available room in the grade they are entering in September. No registrations will be taken over the phone.

NEW REGISTRATIONS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- Family <u>MUST</u> be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- 2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office now thru June 14, 2011. Begins again August 29th thru September 8th. See below for dates & hours.
