#### Holy Day of Obligation

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary in 2012 is celebrated on Saturday, December 8. As the Patronal Feastday of the U.S., this solemnity is always a holyday of obligation (except when transferred to Monday, December 9, as it will be in 2013).
