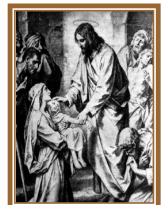

Dear Parishioners,



Convalidations of marriages are a way to remedy a hasty decision to marry too soon. If a couple marries in haste but later recognizes that, yes, they will remain together, the couple can have the union recognized by God and the Church through convalidation. It's not considered an option but a remedy to an unfortunate situation, because the Church prefers couples to marry validly the first time. Sadly, some couples run off and get married civilly or in a modest non-Catholic ceremony just to avoid a large, elaborate, and expensive Catholic wedding. The Church never demands or even suggests big weddings with huge bridal parties, stretch limousines, and country club receptions. Brides are allowed that, but if a couple wants a modest, simple, dignified, and reverent ceremony with a few family and friends and without all the high-priced, big-ticket items that often cost thousands of dollars, they can opt for that in the Catholic Church. The Nuptial Mass or the Rite of Marriage Outside of Mass is appropriate in either situation: elaborate or modest, expensive or economical. The choice is that of the bride and groom. What the Church cares about is the spiritual dimension that this is a sacrament and that marriage is a lifelong vocation and commitment. Society often places more emphasis on the wedding and less importance on the entire marriage.
