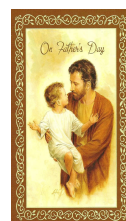

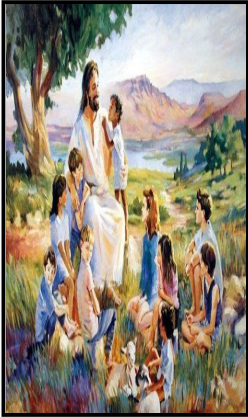

Both new and re-registrations will be taken after the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Mass on June 23rd in Memorial Hall.

RE-REGISTERING STUDENTS

June is the FINAL month for re-registering your children for the 2013-14 school year. **Only SIGNED registrations will be accepted, for**

each child, as required by the Diocese. DO NOT MAIL REGISTRATION TO THE SCHOOL use P.O. BOX ONLY. Must be postmarked by June 27th. Please read your registration letter for increased fees due in June. You may also drop it off to our SCHOOL office thru June 27th, Monday thru Thursday, 9:30 am to 3:30 pm. CLOSED FRIDAYS. **Use the Front door, ring bell. Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 27th, your child will have to wait for the 2014-15 year.**

NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.

Classes begin on Tuesday September 17th or Wednesday September 18th 2013. No other notice will be sent home to you. Class assignments will be posted on those days.

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (at school).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.
1 CHILD \$100.00 2 CHILDREN \$150.00
3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

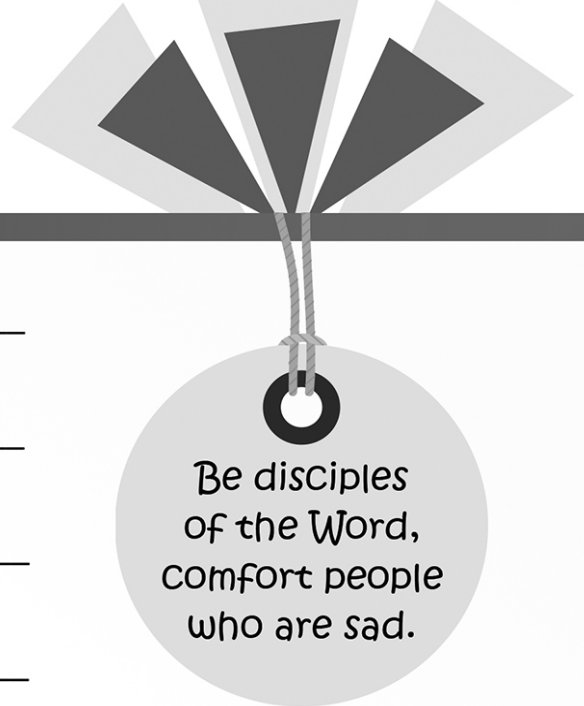

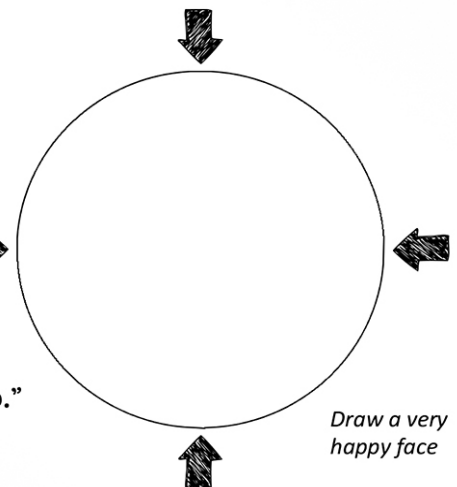
