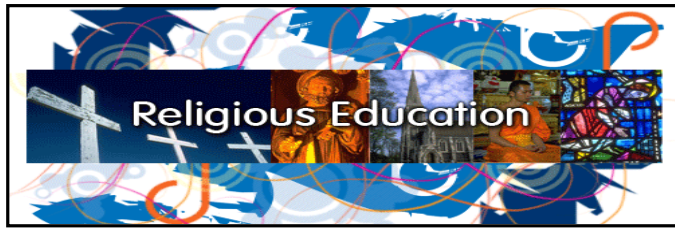

NEW REGISTRANTS 2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR

If you are a *new parishioner* and wish to register your children for our program, please call the religious education office at 732-264-7043 to make an appointment.

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.
**1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150
3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00**
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

Classes begin on Tuesday, September 17, & Wednesday, September 18, 2013. *Re-registrations are now closed for the 2013-2014 school year.*

Today's gospel introduces the Our Father, also known as the **Lord's** (24d) **Prayer** (5d). We learn **further** (32d) **teachings** (19d) about prayer, including how to **pray** (21a) with **your** (12a) **heart** (39a) and mind **open** (10a), and with **persistence** (40a). Jesus says to **ask** (37a), **seek** (29a) and **knock** (30d) to receive answers to prayer and forgiveness of **sin** (31d).

Pray... and the door will be **opened** (16d) to you.
