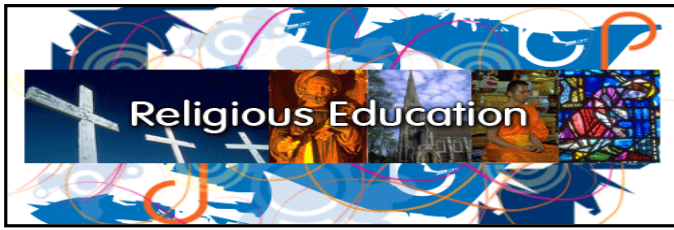
**BISHOP'S

NEW REGISTRANTS 2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR

If you are a *new parishioner* and wish to register your children for our program, please call the religious education office at 732-264-7043 to make an appointment.

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.
**1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150
 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00**
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

Classes begin on Tuesday, September 17, & Wednesday, September 18, 2013. *Re-registrations are now closed for the 2013-2014 school year.*

RE: IMAGE FILM MAKER'S WORKSHOP



The Diocese of Trenton will again sponsor the RE:IMAGE Film Makers' Workshop for high school students who have an interest in filmmaking and want to learn about developing their skills and talents. The workshop is open to any high school student (ages 14-18) who resides in or attends a church or school in Burlington, Mercer, Monmouth or Ocean Counties.

This workshop will take place on two consecutive Saturdays, Sept. 21 and Sept. 28 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the WHYY studio in Philadelphia. The cost for the two-day training is \$30 per person. It will provide students with the unique opportunity to make a short film using WHYY production equipment under the guidance of experienced media instructors.

The aim of the workshop is to introduce the world of filmmaking to high school students, with an emphasis on creating films that fit into the mission of the RE:IMAGE film festival: using the medium to reflect the image of God in the world and humanity. Students attending the workshop will be encouraged to use this workshop training when they go home to produce their own film to enter in the upcoming RE:IMAGE Film Festival, which will take place April 6, 2014 in the Count Basie Theater, Red Bank.

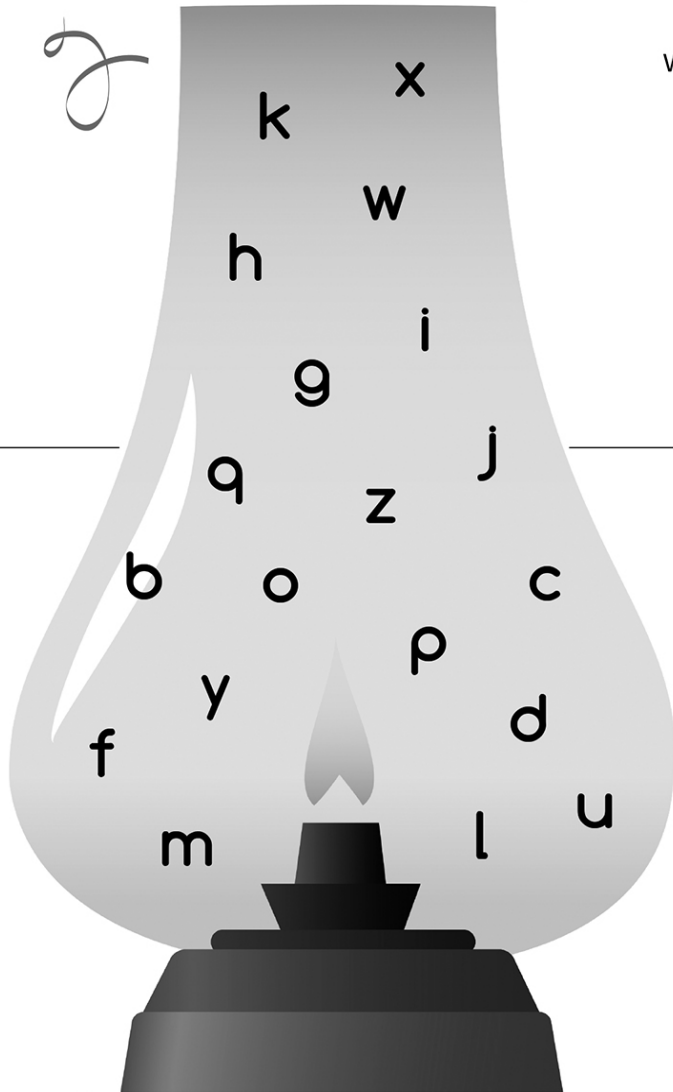
