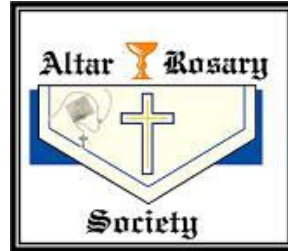

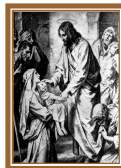

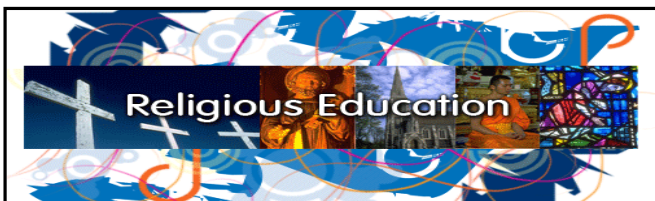


CHILDREN'S CHOIR

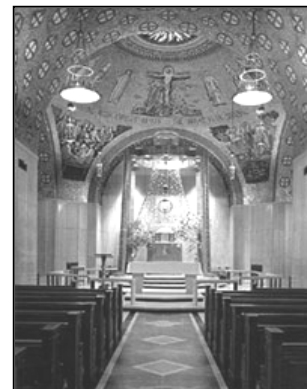

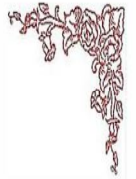
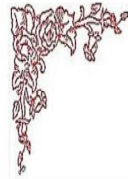
