

Dear Parishioners,



Some ask if the Mass *is about to change*. The answer is ... "no" and "yes." "No," the Mass is not changing from November 27 onwards. There is nothing that has changed in the familiar pattern of our official liturgical prayer. The structure and the entrance rites, the liturgy of the

meaning of the entrance rites, the liturgy of the Word, the liturgy of the Eucharist, and the concluding rites will still remain familiar. "Yes," there will be some retranslated words from modern American English into Latinized worldwide English in our responses at Mass that will cause us for a time to adjust some of our responses and the words of the Gloria and the Creed. Growth involves change. Our Church is not stagnant, but continues to grow in its relationship with Christ. As the Church matures in time, there will always be a need to examine the words and the vocabulary we use in worship. As my (so far) all-time favorite sci-fi novel states and the screenplay for its 1984 big-screen film version repeats, "Without change, something sleeps inside us, and seldom awakens."
