Dear Parishioners,

The Holy Eucharist is a Sacrament in which Christ himself is truly though not visibly present as God and Man, with his glorified Body and Blood, under the appearances of bread and wine, to offer himself on the altar as our sacrifice and to give himself as our

sacrificial food.

The Eucharistic celebration is a holy meal which recalls the Last Supper, reminds us of our unity with each other in Christ, and anticipates the banquet of the kingdom of heaven. In the Eucharist, Christ the Lord nourishes Christians, not only with his word but also with his Body and Blood, effecting a transformation which impels them toward greater love of God and neighbor." (National Catholic Directory, #120).

Are we properly disposed to receive the Lord sacramental Body and Blood every time we attend and participate in Mass? Are we free from sacramentally unconfessed serious (i.e., "mortal") sin when we "go up" to receive Communion? Do we mindlessly receive Communion simply because we are attending a Mass and everyone else in our row seems to be filing out and forward but with ourselves not being properly prepared spiritually?

The gift of the Body and Blood of Christ is a treasure that we will never fully understand or truly appreciate in this life, but hopefully in the life to come forever with the Lord in heaven.


