Dear Parishioners,

The Catechism of the Catholic Church has this to say about salvation for the unbaptized: "Since Christ died for all, . . . we must hold that the Holy Spirit holds to all the possibility . . . Every man (and woman) who is ignorant of the Gospel of Christ and of

his Church, but seeks the truth and does the will of God... can be saved. It may be supposed that such persons would have *desired Baptism explicitly* if they had known its necessity." (1260)

If people in their heart of hearts are sincerely disposed to God's will but, through no fault of their own, don't know about Jesus Christ (e.g., the 6 million Muslim people of Libya and the more than 125 million Shinto and Buddhist people of Japan) -- or they've never been shown by word or good example -- then the Church presumes an implicit desire to be baptized. If someone has told them and given good example (e.g., Mohandas Gandhi, the "Mahatma," who knew about Christianity but was mostly given bad example by preindependence British overlords in his native India). would've freely and willingly embraced Christianity and asked for Baptism by water. That implicit desire coupled with a virtuous life, by the grace of God and their own efforts, can bring them eternal salvation.

DISASTER RELIEF – JAPAN COLLECTION APRIL 9 & 10

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:


- 1. Family <u>MUST</u> be registered in Holy Family Parish, (parish registration is done in person at the rectory office).

- 7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.
