Dear Parishioners,

Catholicism asks for more than the mere physical attendance of the congregation at Mass. The full, conscious, and active participation of the faithful is required by singing, praying, speaking, sitting, kneeling, and


so on. Out of respect for the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, conscientious parishioners dress appropriately as they would if they were sartorially decked out for a wedding, funeral service, or for work in an office, avoiding such clothing that is better suited for the beach, amusement park, a gym workout, picnic, or sporting event, for example.

The priest is the leader of the prayers during Mass, and in this parish assisted by a tiny minority of registered (the 80% or so that do not worship with us on weekends, as a norm) or even regularly-attending parishioners (i.e., the remaining 20%) who are lectors, altar servers, ushers, musicians, choir members, counters, and ministers of the Eucharist; and the prayers of the people join his. Their prayers are different at times and the same at other times. If the priest is standing and the American Catholic people are Catholic Christians to attend Mass every single Sunday and holyday when we are physically able to do so. Full, active, and conscious participation is necessary at each and every Mass.
