Dear Parishioners,

Theologically we use the term "beatific vision" by which we mean we experience God face to face. Once this happens we will be completely satisfied, absolutely fulfilled, never again to experience desires, disappointments, needs, or

cares. Our joy, happiness, and spiritual growth and development will be totally complete. Nothing more could possibly be added. The Beatific Vision transcends every possible human or historical experience.

In the Book of Revelation we read: "Nothing unclean will ever enter it [heaven]" (21:27). Vatican Council II in its *Dogmatic Constitution on the Church* (Number 49) expresses the Catholic teaching that those in heaven, in glory, behold God Himself triune and one, as he is.

In a general audience on May 22, 1974, Pope Paul VI said: "We now live in time, but one day we shall live forever in the Kingdom of heaven. This does not mean the blue sky above but the new state of existence produced in a mysterious and wonderful manner according to God's creative plan and by his power. It is a Kingdom in which we share even now in virtue of certain supernatural conditions and gifts like faith, grace, and divine love. We are partly of earth and partly of heaven. We must know how to live simultaneously on earth and in heaven."

And what of the material world? At the least, should it survive it would be transformed radically. Everything in creation will, in its finality, glorify the Creator. "Eye has not seen, ear has not heard, nor has the human heart imagined what God has prepared for those who love Him" (1 Corinthians 2:9).

Re-Registration MUST be received before June 14, 2011. After that date NO-re-registrations will be taken until AFTER August 29, 2011. A \$50.00 late re-registration fee would be due at that time, and the student will only be accepted if there is available room in the grade they are entering in September. No registrations will be taken over the phone.

NEW REGISTRATIONS
