In the Bible, a mother begged Jesus to drive a demon out of her daughter (Mark 7:25-30). The Church maintains that Jesus, being both God and man, already knew that her daughter was plagued by a demon, so he didn't need the mother to tell him. But he allowed and permitted the mother to get

involved and ask for help on behalf of her child.

Likewise, the Church believes that Jesus doesn't need the saints to tell him anything, but he permits people to ask the saints for help. My father on December 15, 1970, and his father. my grandfather, on November 1969, died thirteen months and two weeks apart from each another, at the ages of 52 and 81, respectively. I believe that both are saints though obviously uncanonized, but that their intercession with the Lord has kept me faithful in my ongoing call in priestly ministry. Humankind is all one family, all made in the image and likeness of God, and all brothers and sisters in Christ, with Jesus being the brother. And the dead whose souls are with God are still part of the family of humankind and still connected to all on earth.




