Dear Parishioners,
Occasionally, a Catholic goes against the laws and advice of the Church and marries a divorced person who hasn't obtained an annulment. This marriage takes place in a civil ceremony, by a non-Catholic minister, or by a defrocked, laicized, or rogue so-called "rent-a-priest," but is not considered valid according to the Catholic Church. If an annulment is granted later on, and the couple wants to have their union recognized and sanctioned as a valid sacrament, then a convalidation is the appropriate and only remedy.

Because annulments aren't guaranteed, Catholics shouldn't presume that they'll get a convalidation after marrying in an invalid civil ceremony.
