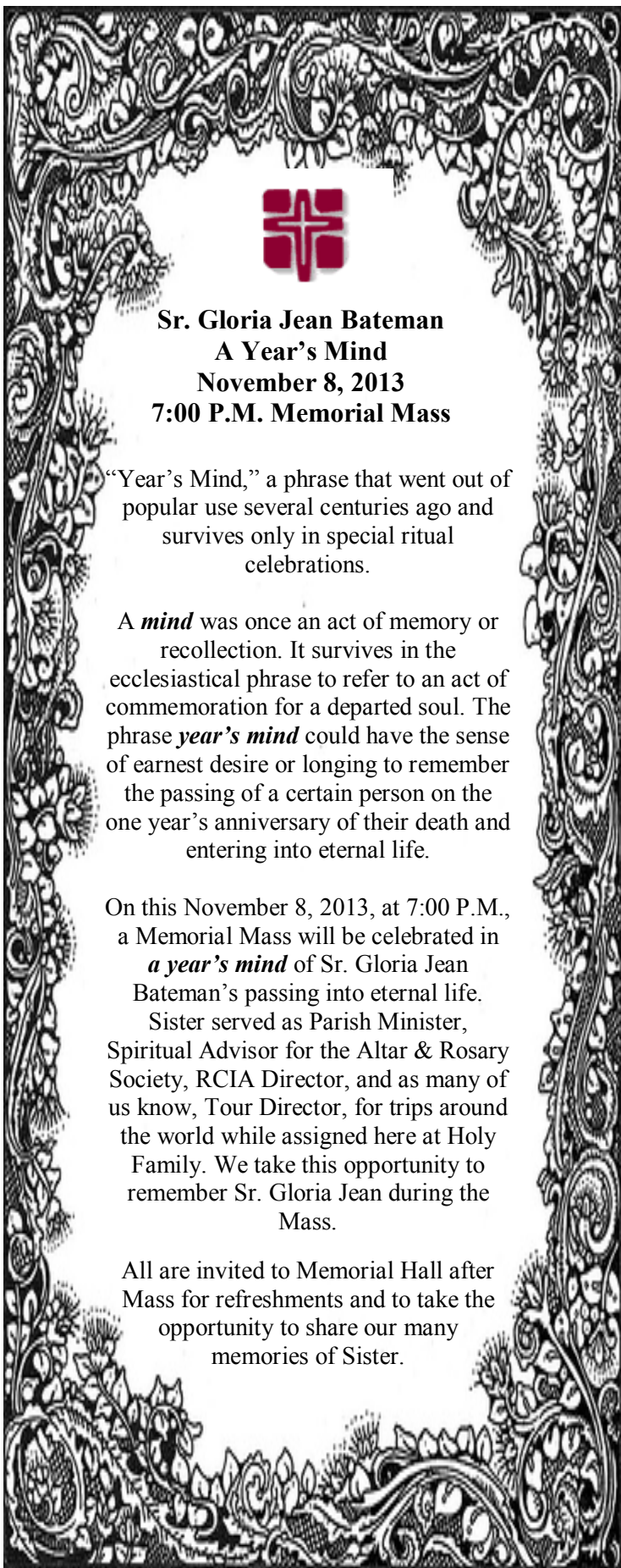
Holy Family Spiritual Adoption Baby Shower and Luncheon

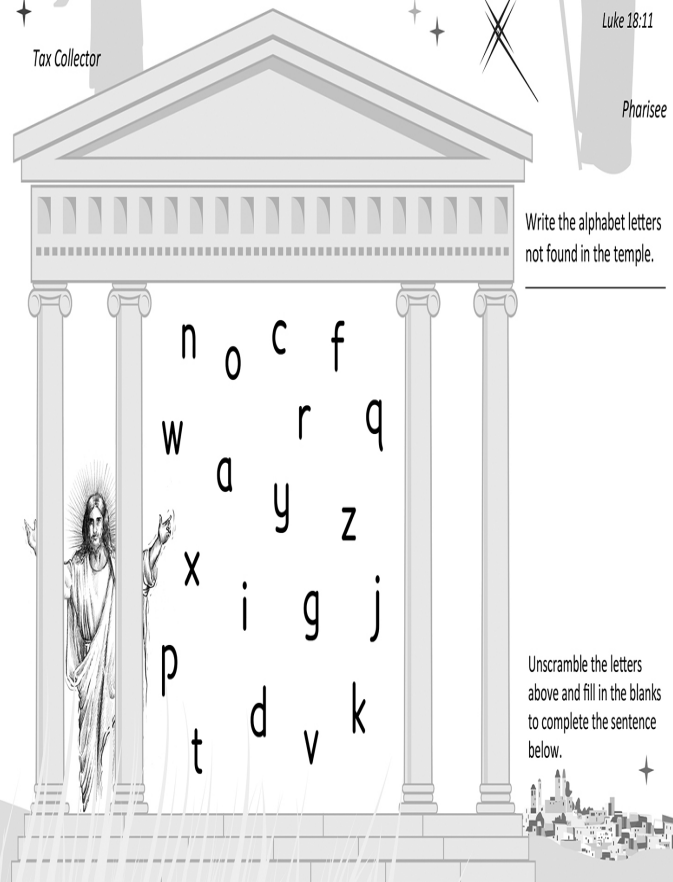
