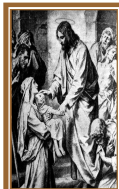

Deacons are ordained for service to the bishop. Deacons do not share in the hierarchical priesthood of Christ, but they have received the sacrament of Holy Orders once, priests twice, bishops thrice, and deacons share in Christ's mission and grace in a special way.

Deacons are ordained especially to serve the bishop, but they also assist the priest, and are subject to the local ministerial direction of their pastors when not directly subject to the bishop in their ministry of service.

Deacons assist at the celebration of the Eucharist. They also distribute Holy Communion, liturgically baptize or christen new members of the Church, prepare engaged couples for matrimony, officiate at and bless marriages, proclaim and preach the Gospel, preside over church funeral services, funeral home wakes or vigils, cemetery burial services, and dedicate themselves to works of charity.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION RE-REGISTRATIONS 2013-2014

Parents with children in our religious education program should have received their re-registration forms by hand from their children (check their folders) for the 2013-2014 school year. Please make any necessary corrections, **SIGN** and return the form, including the non-refundable registration fee, **as instructed in the letter by May 30, 2013.**



NEW DIOCESAN REQUIREMENT

SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. DO NOT MAIL

REGISTRATION TO THE SCHOOL use P.O. BOX ONLY. You may also send it in through your child in April or drop it off to our SCHOOL office May 6th thru May 30th, 9:30 am to 3:30 pm. Front door, ring bell. Fees increase June 3rd thru June 27th. **Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 27th, your child will have to wait for the 2014-15 year.**

NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.

Classes begin on Tuesday September 17 and Wednesday September 18, 2013. No other notice will be sent home to you. Class assignments will be posted on those days.

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.
**1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150
3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180**
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.
