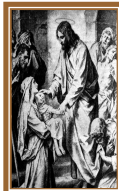

Dear Parishioners,



The bond of Matrimony is permanent, faithful, and open to human life. The permanence of marriage, mirroring the permanence of Christ's love excludes divorce in the sense that divorce ends a marriage. Those validly married couples who are living apart (and who are divorced legally) remain married. There can be no second marriage for a validly married person while the first spouse is still living. The fidelity of marriage, imitating the faithful love of God for his people, excludes polygamy and adultery. The openness to life, which also imitates God's eternally fruitful love, excludes any form of contraception, and Natural Family Planning is not contraception.

**STUDENTS THAT ARE RE-REGISTERING
 NEW DIOCESAN REQUIREMENT**

SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. DO NOT MAIL REGISTRATION TO THE SCHOOL use P.O. BOX ONLY. You may drop it off to our SCHOOL office May 6th thru May 30th, 9:30 am to 3:30 pm. Front door, ring bell. Fees increase June 3rd thru June 27th. **Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 27th, your child will have to wait for the 2014-15 year.**

NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.

Classes begin on Tuesday September 17 and Wednesday September 18, 2013. No other notice will be sent home. Class assignments will be posted on those days.

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.
**1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150
 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180**
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.
