### Mass and Rosary for the Unborn

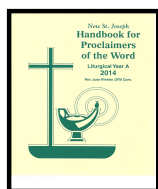

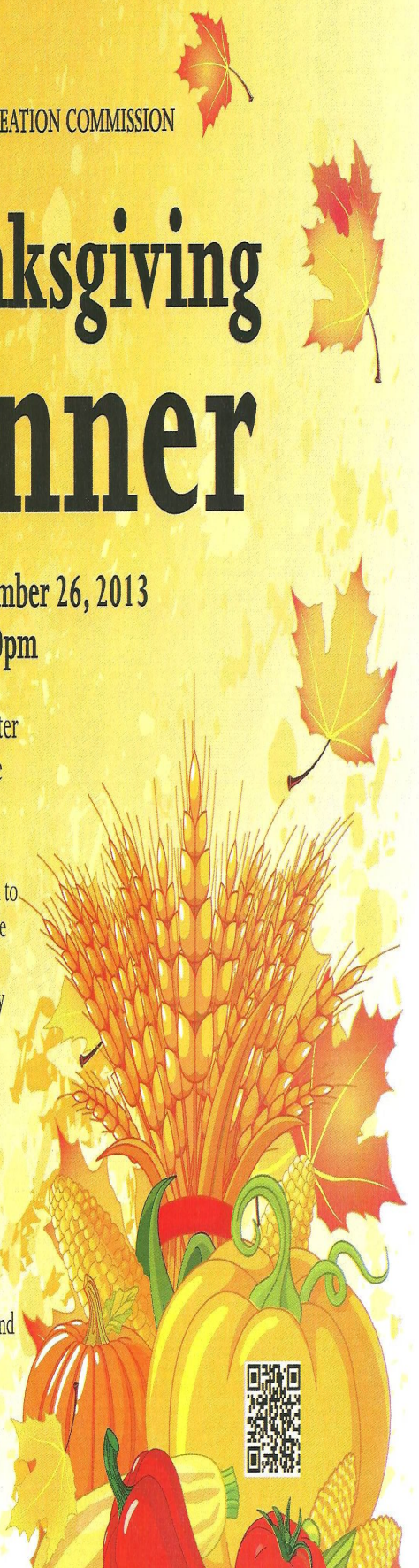
