#### **RE-REGISTRATIONS**

Parents with children in our religious education program received their re-registration forms by hand from their children for the 2014-2015 school year. Please make any necessary corrections, SIGN and return the form, including the non-refundable registration fee, or promissory note by May 29, 2014: SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. DO NOT MAIL REGISTRATION TO THE SCHOOL use P.O. BOX ONLY. You may also drop it off to our SCHOOL office (Front door, ring bell) May 5<sup>th</sup> thru June 30<sup>th</sup>, call for hours.

CLOSED FRIDAYS Fees increase June 2<sup>nd</sup> thru June 30<sup>th</sup>. Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 30. Your child will have to wait for the 2015-16 year. NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.

Classes begin on Tuesday September 16<sup>th</sup> or Wednesday, September 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, or shortly thereafter, depending on your child's grade. First grade begins Sunday, October 5, 2014. No other notice will be sent home to you. Class assignments will be posted on those days. PLEASE READ YOUR LETTERS CAREFULLY!

#### **NEW REGISTRANTS**

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. Family MUST first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- Registration (in person) at the religious education office (At school).
- Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child:

#### 2 CHILDREN \$150 1 CHILD \$100 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00

- 5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
- 6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
- The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.




