

#### **PREP NEWS**

#### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Parents with children in our religious education program should re-register their children for the 2014-2015 school year by June 30th. Please make any necessary corrections, SIGN and return the form, including the non-refundable registration fee, plus increase as of June 2, or promissory note which had been included: SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. DO NOT MAIL REGISTRATION TO THE SCHOOL use P.O. BOX ONLY. You may also drop it off to our SCHOOL office (Front door, ring bell) thru June 30th, call for hours. CLOSED FRIDAYS Fees increased June 2nd thru June 30th. Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 30th, your child will have to wait for the 2015-16 year.

# NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.

Classes begin on Tuesday September 16<sup>th</sup> or Wednesday September 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, or shortly thereafter, depending on your child's grade. First grade begins Sunday, October 5, 2014. No other notice will be sent home to you. Class assignments will be posted on those days. **PLEASE READ YOUR LETTERS CAREFULLY!** 

### **NEW REGISTRANTS**

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. Family <u>MUST</u> first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- **2.** Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
- 3. Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

## 1 CHILD \$100.00 2 CHILDREN \$150.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00

- 5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
- 6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
- 7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

Today we are celebrating the feast of the Holy Trinity.
"Trinity" means "three" and tells us that there are three
Persons in God. There is only one God, but God is a




