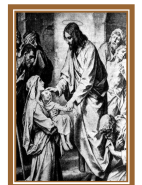

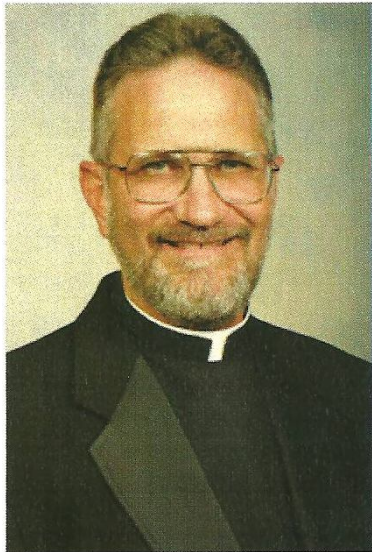

Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate

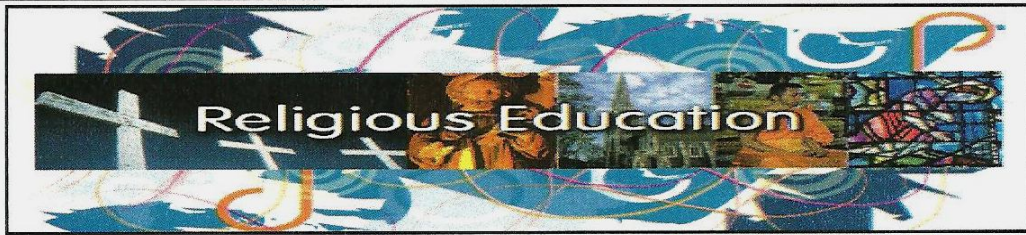

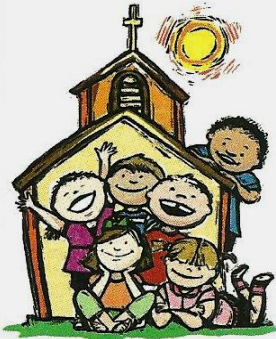
