THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

First Reading: Acts 2:14, 22-33

After the Holy Spirit descends upon the apostles, Peter preaches with great enthusiasm to both Jews and Christians. He recalls for them in vivid terms the miracles and wonders that Jesus performed.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 1:17-21

Peter makes reference to the Passover, when the Jews escaped from Egypt because the blood of the paschal lamb was shed. Now they are being saved from sin by the blood of Christ, the Lamb of the New Testament.

Gospel: Luke 24:13-35

Jesus reveals Himself to two disciples on the way to Emmaus. After explaining to them the passages in Scripture which referred to Him, Christ "took bread, broke it, and distributed it to them." Then they recognized Christ and their "hearts burned within them."

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Parents with children in our religious education program received their re-registration forms by hand from their children (check their folders) the week of April 8, for the 2014-2015 school year. Please make any necessary corrections, SIGN and return the form, including the non-refundable registration fee, or promissory note by May 29, 2014. NEW DIOCESAN REQUIREMENT: SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. DO NOT MAIL REGISTRATION TO THE SCHOOL use P.O. BOX ONLY. You may drop it off to our SCHOOL office May 5th thru June 30th, call for hours. CLOSED FRIDAY'S. Front door, ring bell. Fees increase June 2nd thru June 30th. Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 30th, your child will have to wait for the 2015-16 year. NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.

Classes begin in September. First grade begins Sunday, October 5, 2014. *No other notice will be sent home to you*. Class assignments will be posted on those days. Please read your letters carefully!

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- Family MUST first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- Registration (in person) at the religious education office (At school).
- Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

1 CHILD \$100.00 2 CHILDREN \$150.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00

- A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
- Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.

The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.
