RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Parents with children in our religious education program have until June 25th to re-register their children. Please make any necessary corrections on the registration papers mailed to you, SIGN and return each form, including the non-refundable registration fee, or promissory note (call to request) by June 25th: SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. If mailing please list to the "Attn: PREP office" on envelope. You may also drop it off to our church REL ED office (rear of church, first door on walkway, large parking lot) now thru June 25th, call for hours. WE ARE CLOSED FRIDAYS Fees increased on June 1st, please see letter. Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 25th, your child will have to wait for the 2016-17 year.

PARENTS OF FIFTH GRADE STUDENTS

Classes begin this June 29, 2015, through July 10, 2015. Please enroll your children ASAP.

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. Family <u>MUST</u> first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- **2.** Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (Under the church).
- 3. Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child:

1 CHILD \$100.00 2 CHILDREN \$150.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00

- 5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
- 6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
- 7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.


