RE-REGISTRATION CURRENT STUDENTS

Re-registration has closed for the 2015-16 school year. Those students in second thru eighth grades should have returned their registrations in the mail or in person by June 25, 2015.

NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- 2. Registration (in person) at the religious education office (Under the church).
- 3. Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- 4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

1 CHILD \$100.00 2 CHILDREN \$150.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00

- 5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
- 6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
- 7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.


