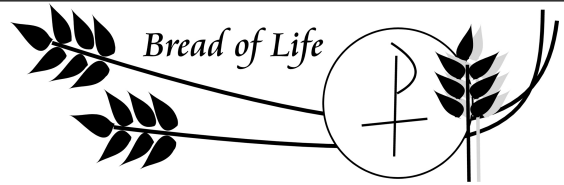

First Reading: Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15

The Israelites complain that Moses led them to the desert and there is no food for them there. Then the Lord told Moses he would rain down bread from heaven so the people might know that Al, the Lord, am your God.@ God did as he had promised and in the morning the people found the bread that he had given them.

Second Reading: Ephesians 4:17, 20-24

Paul tells the Ephesians that they must give up their old way of life and live in accordance with the truth that Christ has brought them. He reminds them to acquire a spiritual way of thinking, and to remember that they are made in God=s image and act accordingly.

Gospel: John 6:24-35

The people Jesus had fed on five loaves of bread follow him, and Jesus tells them they should not be looking for perishable food, but for spiritual food. The people want a sign that they should believe in him. He explains that he is the bread of life, and anyone who believes will not experience hunger or thirst. The people did not fully understand that he was speaking in the spiritual sense, and not of actual food.

MISSION COOPERATIVE APPEAL 2015

Second Collection August 8 & 9

This year's Mission Cooperative Appeal will take place at all the masses the weekend of August 8/9. Fr. Virgilio C. Alburo from the Diocese of Daet in the Phillipines will present the appeal.

Fr. Alburo is a parish priest at St. Philip the Apostle at San Felipe, Basud, Camarines Norte, consisting of nine villages with 20,000 congregants.

Only 25% of the annual high school graduates are able to afford to go onto higher education.

The Diocese of Daet has created the "Helping Each Other Project" where skilled parishioners help train the remaining 75% of the high school graduates and the unemployed for future jobs. The construction of a building to facilitate this training has been initiated but to date, the funds for this project has been depleted with only 30% of the construction completed.

NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (Under the church).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

1 CHILD \$100.00 2 CHILDREN \$150.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00

5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

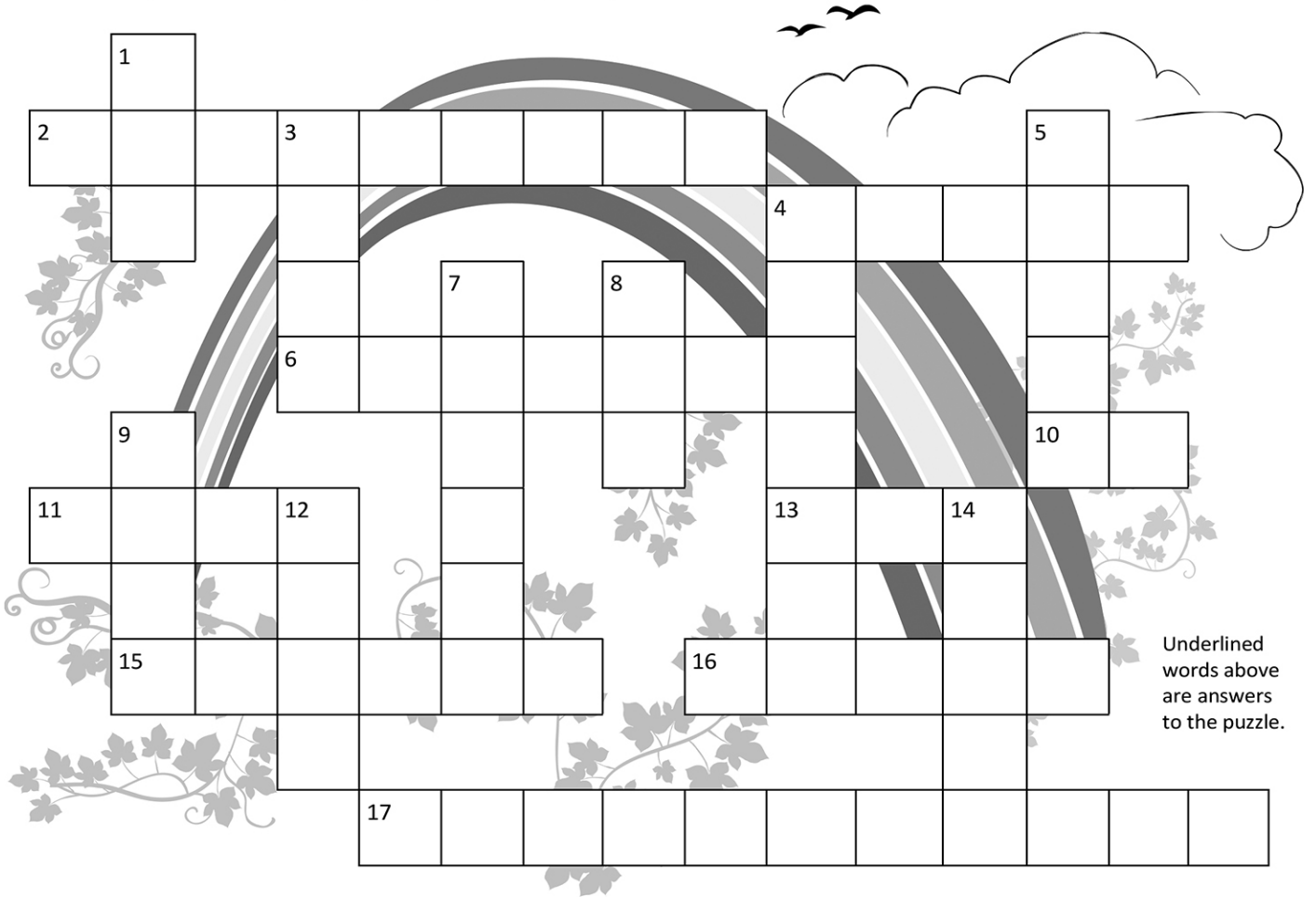
Gospel Today
