

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATIONS CONTINUE

Registration for the 2016-2017 school year continues. Revisions this school year include a 4th grade summer program, the same time as 5th grade, June 27, 28, 29, 30, and July 5, 6, 7, and

8th from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.; and our 1st grade program returns to a Tuesday afternoon, from September thru December from 4:30 to 6:00 p.m.

RE-REGISTRATIONS

Please make any necessary corrections, SIGN and return the form, including the non-refundable registration fee (discount no longer applies as of June 1), or if needed, a promissory note (call to request) by June 30, 2016:

(FOURTH AND FIFTH GRADE PARENTS PLEASE SEND IN ASAP.) SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted for each child. If mailing, please mail to the attention of, "PREP OFFICE." You may also drop it off to our church Religious Education office (rear of church, first door to left off walkway from large parking lot) see registration times below. CLOSED FRIDAYS. Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 30th, your child will have to wait for the 2017-18 year. NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE. PLEASE READ YOUR LETTERS CAREFULLY!

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.

- 3. Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).



Have you missed receiving any of the sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation?



<u>Diocesan Parish Counseling Services</u>: Parishioners have access to short term counseling (up to 6 sessions) at locations


