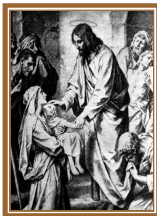

Christian presence in the Holy Land has extended from the Pentecost to the present. Sixty-five years ago, Christians represented more than 28% of the population and now represent less than 2%.
