Parents with children in our religious education program should have received their re-registration forms **by mail** for the 2017-2018 school year the week of April 17th.

Fourth and Fifth grades will only be a summer intensive program, June 26, 27, 28, 29 and July 5 and 6th from 8:30 am to 1:00 pm with returning class for Lent.

Please make any necessary corrections, **SIGN** and return the form, including the non-refundable registration fee, or promissory note (call to request) by May 31, 2017: **(FOURTH AND FIFTH GRADE PARENTS PLEASE SEND IN ASAP, no later than May 31, 2017 to attend the 2017-18 program.)**

SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. If mailing please list to the "Attn: PREP office" on envelope. You may also drop it off to our church **REL ED** office (rear of church, first door on walkway, large parking lot) see registration times below. **CLOSED FRIDAYS.** **Fees increase June 1st thru June 29th.**

Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 29th, your child will have to wait for the 2018-19 year.

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (Under the church).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

1 CHILD \$ 110.00 2 CHILDREN \$ 160.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$ 190.00

5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

God our Father, we entrust to You the young people of our country with their problems, dreams, and hopes.

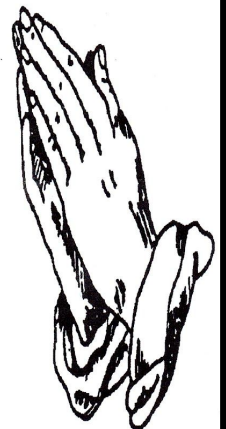
Look upon them with love and call them To follow Jesus, Your Son.

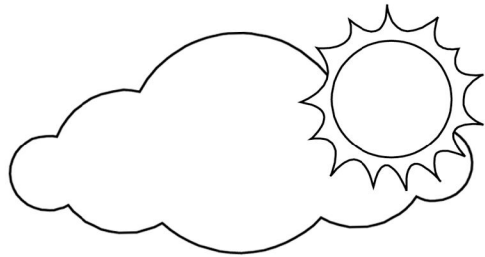

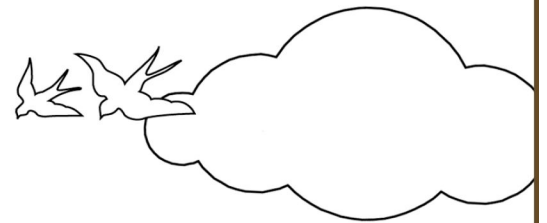

We can't see the wind - only what it moves, and we can't see the Holy Spirit - only what it moves, in people! Is the Holy Spirit moving in you? How?

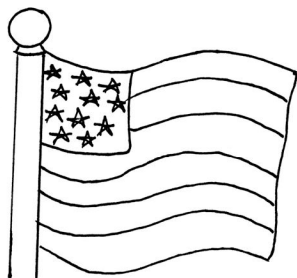
