P.R.E.P. NEWS RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Parents with children in our religious education program should have received their reregistration forms **by mail for the 2017-2018** school year the week of April 17th.

Fourth and Fifth grades will only be a summer intensive program, June 26,

27, 28, 29 and July 5 and 6th from 8:30 am to 1:00 pm with returning class for Lent.

Please make any necessary corrections, <u>SIGN</u> and return the form, including the non-refundable registration fee, or promissory note (call to request) by May 31, 2017:

(FOURTH AND FIFTH GRADE PARENTS PLEASE SEND IN ASAP, no later than May 31, 2017 to attend the 2017-18 program.)

SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. If mailing please list to the "Attn: PREP office" on envelope. You may also drop it off to our church **REL ED** office (rear of church, first door on walkway, large parking lot) see registration times below. **CLOSED FRIDAYS.** Fees increase June 1st thru June 29th.

Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 29th, your child will have to wait for the 2018-19 year.

NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE. PLEASE READ YOUR LETTERS CAREFULLY!

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. Family <u>MUST</u> first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- 2. Registration (in person) at the religious education office (Under the church).
- 3. Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

1 CHILD \$ 110.00 2 CHILDREN \$ 160.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$ 190.00

- 5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
- 6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
- 7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.


