The Lord appears to Moses on Mount Sinai and proclaims to him that he Lord is a "merciful God...slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity."


#### Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 13:11-13

# Welcome to Holy Family Parish

We, the people of Holy Family Parish, in the Diocese of Trenton, are called through Baptism to celebrate the presence of Christ in Word, Sacrament, and Deed. We are called and sent by Christ to live gratefully the life God has

given us and to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ. In the spirit of faith, service, and community, we strive to bring people closer together and closer to God.

#### **Parish Registration**

We welcome you if you are a new member to the parish and invite you to register at the Rectory Office. We encourage you to share in a parish ministry program. You may register at Holy Family in a variety of ways including picking up the form in the rectory or filling the form out online and either mailing it to the rectory, dropping it in the collection basket or hand delivering it to the rectory.

# **Become a Registered Parishioner**

One of the most important things that the people of a parish should do is register. Registering for the parish not only makes you more apart of the family of Holy Family and the Church it gives a chance for you and your family to be counted and heard in the parish

#### Some important reasons to register are the following:

**Sponsor Certificates** - when you are asked to be a sponsor for either Baptism or Confirmation you need a letter signed from your pastor stating that you are a practicing Catholic. If you are not registered in the parish, it is not possible for the pastor to sign these forms.

**Marriage**- For marriage preparation and marriage a letter may be needed from your pastor to allow you to get married in another parish or church.

**Funerals**- when burying a loved one in a catholic cemetery without a funeral mass it is necessary to get priest lines. Unfortunately the pastor needs to know if a parishioner was a

registered member before he can officially sign the documents. **Mailings** - You will receive all parish mailings with regards to special events and announcements.

**Contributions** - registered parishioners receive weekly envelopes to assist with the day to day operations of the parish. These are just a few of the ways that being a registered parishioner can make your experience a better one at Holy Family.

# NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. Family <u>MUST</u> first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- 2. Registration (in person) at the religious education office (Under the church).
- **3.** Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- 4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

1 CHILD \$ 110.00 2 CHILDREN \$ 160.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$ 190.00

- 5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
- 6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
- 7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

# FATIMA 100 YEAR ANNIVERSARY

#### THE SECOND APPARITION OF OUR LADY

On June 13, 1917, accompanied by about 50 people, the children were reciting the rosary, when there was again the lightning, and immediately after the Lady on the holmoak appeared like in May. "What do you want from

me?" asked Lucy. "I WISH YOU TO COME HERE THE 13TH OF NEXT MONTH; THAT YOU SAY THE ROSARY EVERYDAY, AND THAT YOU LEARN TO READ. IN SUCCEEDING MONTHS I WILL TELL YOU WHAT ELSE I WANT." "I would like to ask you to bring us to Heaven: said Lucy.

"YES, JACINTA AND FRANCISCO WILL BE AMONG THE FEW, BUT YOU MUST STAY HERE FOR A LONG TIME. JESUS WANTS YOU TO MAKE ME KNOWN AND LOVED. GOD WISHES YOU TO REMAIN IN THE WORLD FOR SOME TIME BECAUSE HE WANTS TO USE YOU TO ESTABLISH IN THE WORLD A DEVOTION TO MY IMMACULATE HEART. I PROMISE SALVATION TO THOSE WHO EMBRACE IT AND THEIR SOULS WILL BE LOVED BY GOD AS FLOWERS PLACED BY MYSELF TO ADORN HIS THRONE." Lucy asked: "Will I stav here alone?" "DON'T BE DISCOURAGED, I WILL NOT ABANDON YOU EVER. MY IMMACULATE HEART WILL BE YOUR REFUGE AND THROUGH IT WILL CONDUCT YOU TO GOD." Then She opened her hands and emanated her light on the children, Jacinta and Francisco seemed to be in the light that went up toward the sky, Lucy in the light that spread on the earth. In front of the palm of the right hand of Our Lady there was a heart surrounded by thorns that impaled it. They understood that it was the Immaculate Heart of Mary affronted from the sins of men, and she then asked for reparation.

#### Diocese of Trenton Parish Counseling Services

Through a joint effort of the Diocese of Trenton and Catholic Charities, licensed professional counselors are available to help parishioners with

difficult issues such as bereavement, marital and family problems, elder care, stress of job loss. This service can be accessed by contacting the parish office and speaking to one of our priests who will provide additional information and a referral. The fee is \$75 per session. If needed, financial assistance for this short term counseling (up to 6 sessions) is available through the Diocese of Trenton Parish Counseling Services.
