



Diocese of Trenton - Our Promise to Protect



Diocese of Trenton Parish Counseling Services

Through a joint effort of the Diocese of Trenton and Catholic Charities, licensed professional counselors are available to help parishioners with difficult issues such as bereavement, marital and family problems, elder care, stress of job loss. This service can be accessed by contacting the parish office and speaking to one of our priests who will provide additional information and a referral. The fee is \$75 per session. If needed, financial assistance for this short term counseling (up to 6 sessions) is available through the Diocese of Trenton Parish Counseling Services.
